





Leaflet 2 "Cumulative Dissertation"

A cumulative dissertation is only possible upon application (§11 (4) of PromO 2023). The application must be submitted before the application for assessment of admission requirements.

A cumulative dissertation must meet the following criteria:

- 1. There must be a summarising chapter that introduces the topic.
- 2. Most of the results must be published in peer-reviewed journals already or there must be an approval of publication.
- 3. The personal contribution in the publications must be highlighted explicitly.
- 4. The personal contribution must be confirmed by the supervisor. The PhD Committee can gather an external report to clarify the issue.

Implementation rules:

- The reasons for a cumulative dissertation must be justified in the application.
- The summarising chapter should not be shorter than 40 pages.
- The summary should present a thread through the publications. It should take up the contents of the publications and illustrate the link of each publication to the special parts of the scientific work.
- The submitted summary does not have to be identical to the dissertation following.
- The personal contribution must be explained in detail (½ page per publication). Additionally, the percentage must be given for every publication.
- At least three articles as lead author must be published or accepted for publication in international journals. In these publications, the personal contribution must outweigh that of the other authors.
- After submitting the application, any amendment has to be proposed and justified (e.g. submitted papers).
